2. An appraisal of academic and personal qualifications prepared by one of the high school guidance counselors.

3. In addition, please ask two persons other than your peers or family members, such as teachers, employers, pastors, etc., to submit letters of recommendation to be returned to your high school guidance counselor.

Your counselor will forward this application and all required materials to the Community Foundation of Jackson County.
